Woodland Cree First Nation Dog Control Bylaw

It has come to our attention that there has been an increase of stray dogs in the community.

Due to public safety we will be enforcing our Dog Control Bylaw.

As stated in the BYLAW:

D. CONTROL OF DOGS

- (a) run at large on the Reserve, except for within those areas designated as Off Leash areas, if any;
- (b) trespass on private property whether on or off leash
- (c) bite a person or persons whether on the property of the owner or not
- (d) do any other act that cause injury to a person or persons whether on the property of the owner or not;
- (e) chase or otherwise threaten a person or persons whether on the property of the Owner or not;
- (f) bite, bark at or chase stock or other animals, bicycles, automobiles, or other vehicles,
- (g) cause damage to property or other animals; or
- (h) bark or howl excessively

H. GENERAL PROHIBITIONS

Penalty

A person who commits an offence to the bylaw is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$1000 or imprisonment.

A Spay and Neuter Clinic is being set, we will announce it as soon as we have the date.
